Regarding the synonymy that figured so prominently your recent blog "Ferrissia fragilis (Tryon, 1863)" at https://fwgna.blogspot.com/>:

I found myself asking two questions: How did Basch (1963: 435 < https://biodiversitylibrary.org/page/4270143) know the dates (day, month) of **publication** of the three topical synonyms, and could Stimpson know of *Gundlachia californica* Rowell (including a figure thereof) by the time he presented his paper (June 17) other than by having read it in a publication?

Here's what I found about the chronology of the descriptions of these three taxa with some the help from Bruce Neville:

Gundlachia californica Rowell, 1863: 21-22.

Gundlachia californica Rowell, 1863: 21-22. (31) May. Ancylus fragilis Tryon, 1863: 149-150. 13 July. Gundlachia meekiana Stimpson, 1863: 250-252. (31) December

Apparently Bequaert and Miller (1973: 212-213) came to the same conclusion as to the valid name, but without quite as much evidence. Christensen (2010: 5-6) provided an argument vs. *nomen oblitum* status for *A. californica*.
